**Tuition Information Schedule**  
**2025-26**

3K – Full Time Per Child: \$3,679  
 – Part-Time Per Child: \$1,840

4K – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:

- 1 Child: \$3,679
- 2 Children\*: \$3,679 + \$3,054 = \$6,733
- 3 Children\*: \$3,679 + \$3,054 + \$1,840 = \$8,573
- 4 Children\*: \$3,679 + \$3,054 + \$1,840 + \$368 = \$8,830

\* Multi-children discount only applies to students in 4K – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

**Cost to Educate a St. Andrew Student**

2025-26 Tuition (Includes all costs except Co-Curricular)

While tuition covers approximately one third of the cost of educating a student at St. Andrew Parish School, it's the generosity of our community that bridges the gap. The remaining is funded through a combination of school fundraisers, state vouchers (WPCP and SNSP), individual donations, and the Parish's general fund. These combined efforts make Catholic education at St. Andrew Parish School possible, ensuring a vibrant future for this important ministry.

Parishioners and school families alike contribute to the school's financial well-being – parishioners through regular donations, and school families through tuition, fundraising, and engagement in parish activities. Parents are essential partners in this mission, not only by nurturing their children's faith at home but also by volunteering and actively supporting the parish.

### **PAYMENT METHODS**

All tuition and fee payments will be processed through FACTS, an independent company that facilitates private school enrollment and billing systems.

### **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY CHARGES**

Extracurricular activities offered by outside vendors will be billed separately to families. Families not current with their tuition payments may not be permitted to register for extracurricular activities.

### **TUITION AND FEE DELINQUENCY**

The School provides contracts for faculty and staff and acquires materials based on projected student enrollment. Timely tuition payments are crucial for the School and Parish to prevent cash flow problems and maintain financial viability. If you encounter difficulties meeting your agreed-upon tuition payments, please get in touch with the Principal or Parish Business Office to arrange special accommodations and adjustments to your tuition plan.

Payment is due on the date specified in your Payment Schedule with FACTS.

School tuition payments should be current by the following dates:

- September 1, 2025
- November 1, 2025
- January 1, 2026
- March 1, 2026

### **TUITION BALANCE AND ENROLLMENT**

If tuition balances are overdue during the re-enrollment period for the upcoming academic year, new registration and enrollment may be postponed. Before families can re-enroll, all tuition and fees from the current academic year must be paid in full. If you encounter difficulties meeting tuition payments, please inform the Principal or Parish Business Office to arrange special adjustments to your tuition plan.

### **TUITION REFUND POLICY**

Both new and returning students must pay the non-refundable registration and comprehensive fees.

Tuition paid “early” (before it is due) can be refunded if the family transfers from the school during the academic year. For instance, a pro-rated tuition refund will be provided if a family pays the full tuition for the year in September and then moves in January.

Tuition assistance or scholarships from St. Andrew Parish School are forfeited by any student who transfers or is asked to leave the school. Any tuition refund will be calculated without including any tuition assistance or scholarships.
